# Understand the Rules

- TANF Participants have unique responsibilities and rules they must follow:
  - Must be actively engaged with their local Welfare to Work Program
  - Must be approved for vocational activity by the local program
  - Must provide monthly timesheets for tracking purposes

# Working with the Local District

- Vocational Training is an allowable activity and will help the local jurisdiction meet their participation requirements
- Meet with the local district to inform them of your HPOG funding and explain how it will help reduce active rolls
- Identify supportive services available by local district

# Tricks of the Trade

- Vocational training may be combined with work activity to satisfy TANF requirements
- This technique can be especially useful for TANF clients who have exceeded their vocational time limits
- Make your site an approved worksite for the local program
